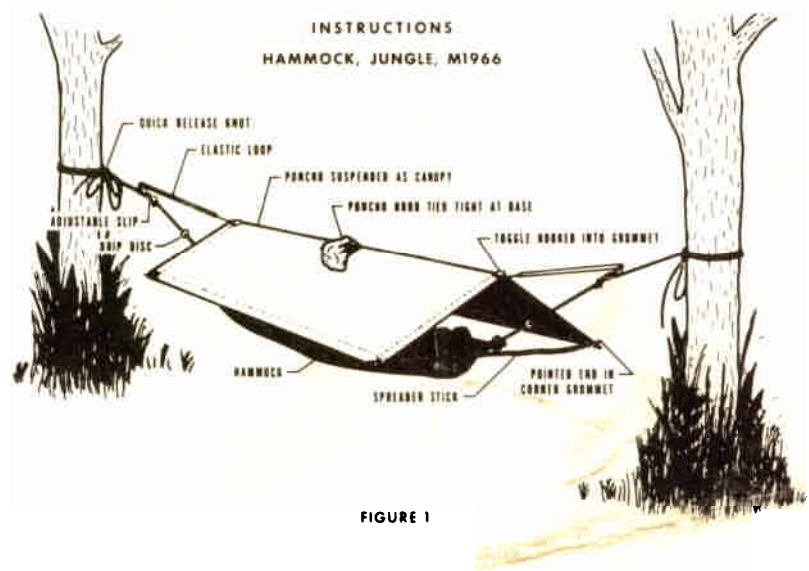

**1. CARRYING**

- Fold hammock with accordion-like folds with one hammock rope tucked in a fold and other rope wrapped around folded hammock

**2. SUSPENDING**

- Clear space between two trees at least 10' apart
- Clear all sharp objects and projections from beneath hammock
- Suspend hammock between trees tying off with quick release knot (See back of card)

**3. ATTACHMENT OF PONCHO**

- (For rain protection suspend poncho over hammock as shown in illustration)
- Put toggle attached to elastic loop on suspension rope at one end of hammock through center grommet in one end of poncho. Repeat at opposite end of hammock and poncho.
  - Adjust elastic loop slips on suspension ropes so that ridge line of poncho is nearly a straight line when hammock is suspended.
  - Cut two spreader sticks not over 5' long and sharpen the ends. Put a stick between the corner grommets at each end of the poncho with the points through the grommets. Sticks should be beneath hammock suspension ropes.
  - Position rubber drip disc just above suspension rope knot at each end of hammock.
  - The poncho can be kept attached to the hammock or removed as desired.

**4. END SPREADER(S) (when desired)**

- Cut spreader stick about 28" long and 1 1/4" in diameter.
- Position elastic loop slip and rubber drip disc approximately one foot from end of rope.
- Pull free end of hammock rope out of small loop at other end of rope. Keep rope in tunnel-hem and adjust so that two protruding ends are equal.
- Pass stick through tunnel hem.
- Tie rope to each end of stick with clove hitch (2 reversed half-hitches)
- Tie cords attached to nylon loops around stick outside of rope knots.
- Tie ends of rope together with square knot two feet up from stick ends.
- Tie ends of rope around tree.
- End spreader is normally used at head end only but can be used at foot end also if desired.

**5. KEEP HAMMOCK CLEAN**

(Rinse often. Wash in detergent or soap and warm water.)

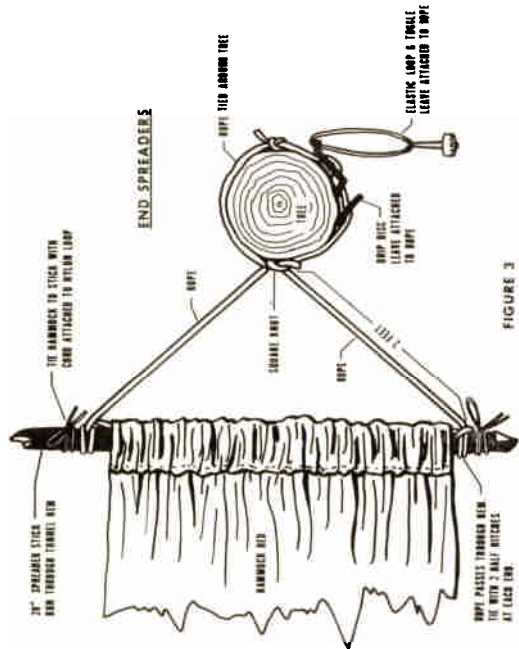
